

Barbers Auctions Machinery Sale Terms & Conditions

- ENTRY** All lots must be delivered to the site in accordance with the terms stated on the entry form.
- Unless otherwise agreed by the auctioneers no entries can be accepted on the day of sale.
- All lots brought onto the site must be offered for sale by auction and must not be sold privately before the sale, such transactions will be treated as a sale through the auction.
- Following the sale of any vehicles the vendor must provide a V5 registration document where appropriate.
- An entry fee of £5 will be added to all unsold lots.
- REGISTRATION** All purchasers must be registered with the Auctioneers. Clients who have existing computer numbers please use them.
- PRE-SALE** Pre-sale enquiries may be made to the Auctioneer's office at Barbers Auctions on 01630 652926. Contact telephone numbers on the sale day Ben 07791 791356 or Mark 07813 625787.
- VAT** VAT at the standard rate will be charged on all entry fees. (20%).
- RESERVES** Any reserve placed on items in the sale must be registered with the auctioneers prior to commencement of the sale.

RICS CLIENT MONEY PROTECTION SCHEME:- All financial transactions within this market are conducted with the Auctioneers acting as Principal. Sale proceeds are not paid into a client bank account and, consequently, the RICS Client Money Protection Scheme (CMPS) will not apply to protect the vendor.

- COMMISSION** Commission will be charged to the vendor at the following rates :-
- Implements/Tools under £50 will be charged at 10% plus VAT and incur a £1 lotting charge per item.
 - Implements/Equipment £51 to £250 charged at 10%, plus VAT.
 - Implements/Equipment over £251 charged at 7.5%, plus VAT.
 - Tractors and Equipment over £2,000 charged at 5.5% of the item total plus VAT.

CONDITIONS OF SALE The Auctioneers' usual conditions of sale will apply and will be posted on the day of the sale.

TERMS OF SETTLEMENT Cash on day of sale. Anyone wishing to pay by cheque not known to the Auctioneers must obtain a Banker's Reference or make suitable prior arrangement with the Auctioneers.

REMOVAL OF ITEMS All sold and unsold lots to be removed before 12 noon on the Monday following the sale.

All lots must be accompanied by proof of purchase in order to leave the site.

Any lot which has not been collected before the Monday deadline, unless arranged in advance with the auctioneers will be stored at a rate of £5 per lot per week.

Any item/s not collected within one month of the sale date will be deemed abandoned and the auctioneers will be entitled to dispose of the item/s at their discretion.
