Just shy of the magical 200 mark and not quite the vintage show of last week. On the day a large contingent of plain and leaner cattle which would not have enhanced the averages!! Fortunately being a green further finishers could operate and absorbed the cattle which would be too lean or light to slaughter. Trade remains extremely buoyant for well fleshed cattle but just not enough forward to service increasing demand. Top calls rang out to 288p for steers, 286p for heifers and 259p for bulls.
