Numbers remaining tight both locally and nationally, and this seems to be fuelling the cow trade to unprecedented levels for the time of year! Demand throughout the red meat industry looks set to be buoyant, due to more events and industries opening up and reduced imports into the country. Lets hope this trade remains and you as clients are rewarded for the quality of the livestock you produce. Food has been too cheap for too long, and farmers like all industries need to be profitable to ensure sustainability, not to mention the role you play as custodians of the countryside.
